PR24/2011	<u>The Chairman welcomed those present.</u> There were no members of the public present. In the absence of the Clerk, Cllr. Hosken took the Minutes.	
PR25/2011	<u>Apologies for absence</u> – Cllrs Roberts (ex officio), The Clerk, Mr Les Hudson (ill health), Cllrs Muriel and Jeffery.	
PR26/2011	<u>Contract</u> - Clerk to request Mr Bob Sanders of RTS Garden Services to attend the September meeting.	Clerk
PR27/2011	<u>Contract</u> – Risk Assessments. The Clerk to notify RTS Garden Services to the changes attended to the Risk Assessments and, subject to these being included, the Risk Assessments are satisfactory.	Clerk
PR28/2011	<p><u>PROW Issues</u> – Colin Bayes advised the meeting that he is now part of Cormac and therefore any contact in the first instance should be via Mike Eastwood. Turning to the three outstanding issues, Mr Bayes commented as follows:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. <i>Footpath 207/3/2</i> – Mr Bayes has made contact with the owner, a Mr Tilly. Further research is required by Mr Bayes. Cllr Trevan to approach Les Hudson to see if a discussion can be commenced with Mr Tilly regarding a temporary permissive path in the meantime. Mr Bayes advised that there would almost certainly be enforcement action with regard to the cattle grid across the footpath and further research was required relating to the original planning permission.</li> <li>b. <i>Footpath 207/21/2 into 111/23/1</i> – Mr Bayes advised that the section which is the responsibility of Crowan Parish Council is currently in order. The path has lucerne growing on it but it is usable as a footpath. It appears that the section of St Erth Parish has been ploughed and this matter has been referred to the officer responsible for that area. Mr Bayes requested details of when the path is next ploughed up and then there is a 14 day period for reinstatement after which action can be taken.</li> <li>c. <i>Footpath 207/118</i> – Mr Bayes visited the site on 13<sup>th</sup> July 2011 and was advised that a diversion order is being put forward. However, this requires the path to be moved on to a neighbour's land and requires the neighbour's approval. Mr Bayes advised that from his research it appears that planning made an error by not realising the footpath was there despite being advised by Crowan Parish Council. Mr Bayes requested that the Clerk look back through the minutes to find reference to this footpath by Parish Council.
