PR3/2014	<p><u>PROW Issues</u> – Minute PR19/2013 refers.</p> <p>a. <i>PROWs 207/113, 207/124, 207/125, 207/126, 207/127, 207/131, and 207/139</i> – Mr Bayes reported he and Ms Holloway are to make site visits and carry out of a survey to identify the issues. The Clerk to seek further information.</p> <p>b. <i>PROWs 207/50, 207/53, 207/101, 207/105 and 207/110</i> – outstanding s.130a notices. It was AGREED to take no further action.</p> <p>c. <i>Carn Meor Farm (PROW Number required)</i> – Cllr Webb reported that stuff has been dumped there but removed, the path is currently clear. It was AGREED that Cllr Webb will continue to monitor.</p> <p>d. <i>PROW 74/2</i> – Mr Hamish Gordon had met with the landowner on site and had supplied him with provisional authorisation to fit kissing gates at the locations that he requested. To date the relevant maps and S.147 application forms have not been returned. Mr Gordon is pursuing the matter.
