| PR22/2014 | <u>PROW Issues</u> – Minute PR19/2013 refers.<br>a. <i>PROW207/118</i> – Members to consider a proposal from CC to divert this footpath. <b>APPROVED</b> .<br>b. <i>PROW/207/124</i> – March Public forum refers. To be carried forward to next meeting, as there was no update.<br>c. <i>Carn Meor Farm (PROW Number required)</i> – Cllr. Webb reported that hardcore had appeared but there had been no further tipping. Yurts had been erected on site.<br>d. <i>Higher Trethannas Farm, Praze</i> – the landowners had responded to Members' request that defects to the stiles on the Rights of Way and Bridlepaths on their land be rectified, by asking for the precise locations. Mr Sanders had undertaken to contact Mr Rowe and carry out a survey. Mr Bayes advised had dealt with Mr Rowe in the past and is happy to take this forward if there is no positive response and action from Mr Rowe. For further consideration at the next meeting.<br>e. <i>Public Byway, Halgarrack Farm</i> – (December Public Forum refers). Cllr. Henwood undertook to make a site visit to investigate the byway, which is blocked by two posts at Halgarrack Farm. It is alleged this has been the case for a couple of years. Mr Bayes provided an extract from the definitive map, which indicates that Byway 58 runs close to Halgarrack Farm House and Cottage, however, public rights may exist along the more direct route, too. All leaflets to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. A request for walkers to keep their dogs under control, according to CC leaflet, to be included.</li> <li>ii. The same ‘history of Crowan’ as in the Coronation leaflet. Cllr. Muriel to transcribe to ‘Word’ and forward to Cllr. Smith.</li> </ul> <p>The first two leaflets would be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. A short walk from Crowan Church to Clowance, along the back of the doctors’ surgery, then up through Tremayne and back. This would include Cllr. Brown’s walk. Cllr. Smith confirmed that most of walk was adequately marked, but the section between Tremayne and Praze-an-Beeble required new signposting.</li> <li>ii. A short walk around Leedstown with historical notes. Cllrs. Brown and Webb hoped to be able to complete the walk and report to the next PROW meeting.</li> </ul> <p>NOTE – the St Aubyn Arms had agreed to help with the cost of producing leaflets describing the walks.</p> |  |
