PR40/2014	<p><u>PROW Issues</u> – Minute PR30/2013 refers.</p> <p>a. <i>PROW/207/124</i> – March Public forum refers. Members to receive an update, regarding outstanding issues on the land owned by Mr and Miss Pearce. Deferred from the October meeting.</p> <p>b. <i>Carn Meor Farm (PROW Number required)</i> – Members to receive an update, regarding monitoring of the rubbish that was accumulating. Deferred from the October meeting.</p> <p>c. <i>Public Byway, Halgarrack Farm</i> – (December Public Forum refers). Cllr. Henwood had undertaken to make a site visit to investigate the byway, which is blocked by two posts at Halgarrack Farm. It had been alleged this has been the case for a couple of years. Deferred from the October meeting.</p> <p>Mr Bayes had provided an extract from the definitive map, which indicated that Byway 58 runs close to Halgarrack Farm House and Cottage, however, public rights may exist along the more direct route, too.</p> <p>d. <i>Carsize Lane</i> – Members to consider possible improvements for access to the site. Referred from the Amenities Committee. Deferred from October.</p> <p>e. <i>PROWs 113 & 114</i> – Mr Sanders and Mr Bayes, CC have made a site visit and established a route and this path will be cleared in the near future, there will be no additional cost above the LMP costings. He will talk to Mr Hamish Gorden regarding signage.</p> <p>f. <i>PROW 100</i> – Mr Sanders and Mr Bayes had made a site visit and established the correct path and Mr Bayes has photographed the obstructions and these will be dealt with by enforcement.</p> <p>In respect to the area within the bog they have confirmed what construction needs to take place and Mr Sanders will be advising the prices in the next couple of weeks.
