PR12/2016	<u>PROW Issues</u> – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. <i>PROW 18/1</i> – blockages at the gateways had been reported to Mr Colin Bayes, CC.</li> <li>b. <i>PROWs 53 and 58</i> – Ms Linda Holloway reported these had been completed. The landowner has removed all gates and posts. With regards to the trench, this cannot be dealt with under a s.130 notice, it needs to be a s.56 Notice. However, Mr Colin Bayes and Ms Holloway are looking into it.</li> <li>c. <i>PROW 117/1, Crowan to Reservoir</i> – Minute PR4e/2016 refers. A member of the public had reported the path is not clear on the ground.</li> <li>d. <i>PROW 120/1, Road Junction at Bolitho Vean as far as Bolitho Barton</i> – Minute PR4d/2016 refers. Ms Catherine Szlichta, Cormac Countryside Information Officer (West) emailed (20/01/16) to say this path had been reported as being “indiscernible” because of vegetation growth. Mr Sanders had been asked for his comments.</li> <li>e. <i>Fingerposts</i> – Minute 31b[i]/2016 refers. Members to consider the work needed and to apply for funding from the Clowance Trust.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Nancegollan</u> – SW6331. Column rusted, and needs replacing. Only two arms, but logically it should have three. A well is situated nearby.</li> <li>• <u>SW6331 Nancegollan</u> – fingerpost needs a new column and possibly a new cast iron arm.</li> <li>• <u>Townshend</u> – SW5932. New alloy arm needed. Cllr. Allen said the missing arm was stored for a long time in a nearby garden.</li> <li>• <u>Highdowns</u> – SW6636. Needs repainting.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Information

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Boldgate</u> – SW6235. Needs repainting.</li> <li>• <u>Praze an Beeble</u> – SW6435. New alloy arm needed.</li> <li>• <u>Leedstown</u> – SW6034. Made by Toy Foundry, Helston. Included in the listed building status of the Duke of Leeds pub. New column needed, replace one iron arm, replace two alloy arms, repainting.</li> <li>• <u>Clowance</u> – SW6235. Needs cleaning.</li> </ul> <p>No further action is needed on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Releath</u> – SW6532. In very good condition when surveyed in 2014.</li> <li>• <u>Black Rock</u> – SW6635. Iron, with broken arm. Members believed this to have been restored.</li> </ul> <p>NOTE – an application for funding had been made to the Clowance Trust for £2,500. The Trust is due to meet next on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2016.</p> <p>f. <i>PROW 136/2</i> – Ms Catherine Szlichta, Cormac Countryside Officer had advised this path is unusable as the result of very dense undergrowth. Mr Sanders advised that this is a discretionary (silver) path and leads nowhere. It is blocked by several trees and he has not attempted to clear it. Ms Szlichta has been informed accordingly.</p>	Information
