NOTE – update requested 07/06/2016 b. <i>PROWs 53 and 58</i> – Ms Linda Holloway reported these had been completed. The landowner has removed all gates and posts. With regards to the trench, this cannot be dealt with under a s.130 notice, it needs to be a s.56 Notice. However, Mr Colin Bayes and Ms Holloway are looking into it. NOTE – update requested 07/06/2016 c. <i>PROW 117/1, Crowan to Reservoir</i> – Minute PR4e/2016 refers. A member of the public had reported the path is not clear on the ground. Ms Holloway is looking into it. Mr Sanders said signs were needed for this PROW. Member to be appointed to speak to the farmer. d. <i>Fingerposts</i> – Minute PR4h/2016 refers. A grant had been awarded by the Clowance Trust of £2,500 to assist in carrying out repairs to the fingerposts. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <u>Nancegollan</u> – SW63 3185. Column rusted, and need replacing. Only two arms, but logically it should have three. The missing arm should say Nancegollan, mileage needed. 2. <u>Townshend</u> – SW5920 3285. New alloy arm needed. The missing arm may be stored in a nearby garden. Signs to read [1] Leedstown 1 ¼, Praze 3 and Camborne 5; [2] Godolphin 1, Breage 3 ½, Helston 6. 3. <u>Carvolth / Highdowns</u> – SW6628 3602. New column needed, replace one iron arm, replace two alloy arms, repainting. Three new arms to read: [1] Hayle, [2] Helston and [3] Redruth.</p> <p>7. <u>Nine Maidens</u> – SW6743 3683. Needs repainting.</p> <p><u>No further action is needed on the following:</u></p> <p>8. <u>Releath</u> – SW6595 3279. In very good condition when surveyed in 2014.</p> <p>9. <u>Black Rock</u> – SW6623 3518. Iron, with broken arm. Members believed this to have been restored.</p> <p>e. <i>PROW 136/2</i> – Ms Catherine Szlichta, Cormac Countryside Officer had advised this path is unusable as the result of very dense undergrowth. Mr Sanders advised that this is a discretionary (silver) path and leads nowhere. It is blocked by several trees and he has not attempted to clear it. Ms Szlichta had been informed accordingly.</p>	Information

Minute PR5/2016 refers.</p> <p>a. <i>Crowan to Clowance to Crenver Grove Leaflet</i> – Members to receive an update, to include locations where signposts are needed and consideration to add PROW 78 to the cutting schedule.</p> <p>NOTE – Mr Gwennap, landowner had previously indicated he is unwilling to have a sign on PROW 78. Members to consider asking again, in view of the fact that the PROW will form part of the leaflet route. Mr Sanders had warned that there could be resistance from local landowners.</p> <p>Mrs Pawluk reported, through the Clerk, that she had been in touch with Pip Richards of the Sustainable Trust. It transpires that circular walks had been published on their Carwynnen Quoit website as an interactive map which are printable and are also available in leaflet form, including the one we had been working on from Crowan. They had received funding to formulate these professionally. They plan to add further circular routes some of which may be in the parish. In view of this, Members to consider creating a link from Crowan PC’s website and to take no further action i.r.o. printing leaflets.</p>
