The purpose of the Neighbourhood Plan is to ensure that future building developments meet the specific policies developed for the Parish of Crowan that fit within the Cornwall Council Local Plan as agreed with Parliament. These policies have come about as the result of the Survey that was carried out in 2015 covering environment, facilities, amenities and services as well as future building developments, plus consultations with residents over that time by the Steering Group members.

Printed copies are available for inspection at the **St Aubyn Arms & Duke of Leeds** public houses and also at the **Praze Surgery** so that you can raise any queries or comment on the content.

This Pre-Submission draft has been sent to around forty statutory and other bodies for their review and comment as well as open to local Crowan Parish residents for their comments, which are covered under the terms of the GDPR for confidentiality. The Pre-Submission Consultation period **closes on Friday 31 August 2018**.

The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group has had a presence at various local events since the draft report launch in July to explain the full purpose and receive comments. Further Notices of local consultation meetings will appear on the Crowan Parish Council Notice Boards.

There is still a need for some good photographs to show the best of Crowan Parish, for inclusion in the final report that will take account of the feedback and comments received. The final version of the Neighbourhood Plan will be subject to further examination and approval prior to publishing and the policies will only be adopted following a parish referendum.
