The ***Neighbourhood Plan*** is to ensure that future building developments up to 2030 meet the specific policies developed for the **Parish of Crowan**, whilst also meeting the objectives of the **Cornwall Council Local Plan**, as agreed with Parliament. The Parish covers a large area and includes **Leedstown, Nancegollan, Townshend, Praze-an-Beeble and Crowan**.

These policies have been developed by the Steering Group based on the information obtained from the 2015 Parish Survey together with feedback from parish residents and covers facilities, amenities, services, employment, tourism, heritage, environment and renewable energy as well as future building developments.
