Crowan Parish Council attended site and talked to the applicant about this application, which seeks to join two buildings to allow for the continued home care of an elderly relative. Councillors noted that one of the affected gable walls had been restored recently, and that the Conservation Officer is content with the proposal. The barn will remain subsidiary to the main building, and no additional people will be accommodated. There is no issue with unwanted light as the glass tunnel is short and between two relatively high building. The council believes this will make good use of a redundant building and notes the improvement that will be brought about by the replacement of asbestos slate with real slate. SUPPORTED.
