Minutes Of The A&E Committee Held In The Parish Room Crowan On Thursday September 3, 2026, At 7.15p.m.

26-09/01A	Apologies Received and accepted from Councillor K. Allen.
26-09/02A	Members Declarations None.
26-09/03A	Requests For Dispensation None received.
26-09/04A	Public Forum No members of the public present.
26-09/05A	Nancegollan Play Equipment Replacement Councillor Chapple presented on a recent public consultation meeting attended by Councillors Thould and Jenkin, the Clerk and a small number of village residents including young people. People had given strong support to the replacement programme and contributed ideas about the equipment they would like to see. Exercise equipment for older people was also mentioned. The committee RESOLVED to recommend to Council that defining and carrying out the tender should be devolved to Councillors Chapple, Thould and Jenkin supported by the Clerk, with regular updates being made to other councillors.
26-09/06A	Praze Plan Councillor Parnell reported on on-going negotiations with Clowance over the installation of an all-weather path. The Clerk reminded members that the project would need to be tendered for and that funding for the project had not been included in the last budget. Councillor Parnell will forward costs to the Clerk when he has them and update the committee at a future meeting.
26-09/07A	Cornwall Council Fly-Tipping Campaign Councillors agreed that the following sites should be identified to Cornwall Council as locations where there should be a focus to prevent fly-tipping: • A lay-by on the Nancegollan to Godolphin road (in neighbouring parish) • Crenver Corner • A location on the Praze to Black Rock road • Cargenwen Reservoir carpark The Clerk will respond on behalf of the council.
26-09/08A	Remembrance Day The Clerk reported that a road closure request has been submitted and the Minister has confirmed her attendance. Other preparations are in hand. Councillor Parnell asked to be reminded by the Clerk of the need to confirm Marshalls for the road blocks with the cricket club. It was agreed that the Marshalls should meet with Councillor Thould on site in advance of the road closure.
